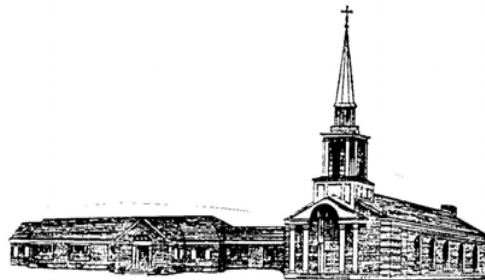

## Local Community Outreach
